

SOUTH CENTRAL OHIO DISTRICT NEW WORK GLOSSARY

New work- Any new church, multi-site, PAC, or mission outpost.

New Works Team- The District team that leads, trains, supports, and supervises new works on the District.

Church Plant- A church plant is the “traditional” way of referring to a new church start up. The South Central will now call a church plant a new start.

Church- A group of people **who have covenanted together** to meet regularly for discipleship, worship, and evangelism for the glory of God.

PAC- Parent Affiliated Congregation. A group of people meeting as an extension of an existing church for the purpose of fulfilling the Great Commission. The PAC comes under the structure and accountability of an existing church and pastor. Due to the unique nature of a PAC, the group may never become its own officially organized church.

Mission Outpost- A group of like-minded Nazarenes who meet in an area for discipleship, worship, evangelism, and fellowship.

DCPI- Dynamic Church Planting International. This group is the organization that the Church of the Nazarene New Start Director, Bill Wiesman, has partnered with to deliver training, coaching, and mentoring for potential church planters and pastors who decide to start new works through their churches.

CPE- Church Planting Essentials. This training is for new start leaders who are about to start new works or are interested in learning more about this possibility.

CPC- Churches Planting Churches. This training is for pastors who are about to start new works through their churches or are interested in learning more about this possibility.

Team Leader Assessment- Church Planter Assessment is an intensive four day training designed to assess whether a person is gifted and qualified to start a new work or church. South Central Ohio District requires assessment for all leaders who will receive financial support from the District. The leader and spouse need to attend the assessment together. As of, October 2014, South Central Ohio District will have its own team of assessors. The Church of the Nazarene website also offers a \$29 online pre-assessment.

DCPI Certified Trainer- A person who has been certified to train at DCPI training events.

DCPI Master Trainer- A person who has been certified to train and certify trainers at DCPI events.

Team Leader- The team leader is the title of any new work on the South Central Ohio District.

Mentor- A leader who meets with another leader for coaching, support, prayer, and accountability.

Certified Assessor- A person who is certified to participate in as an assessor at Church Planer Assessment event.

Assessment Director- A person who is certified to lead assessment centers and certify assessors.

Master Assessment Director- A person who is certified to lead assessment centers, certify assessors, and certify assessment directors
